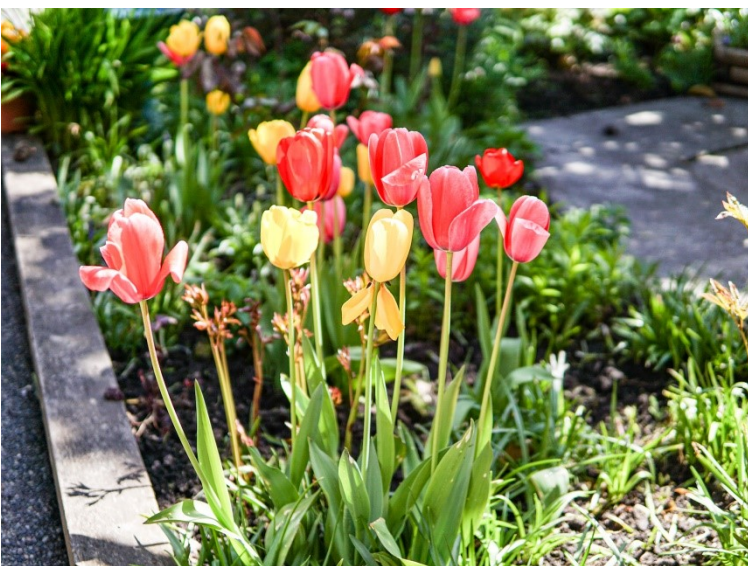


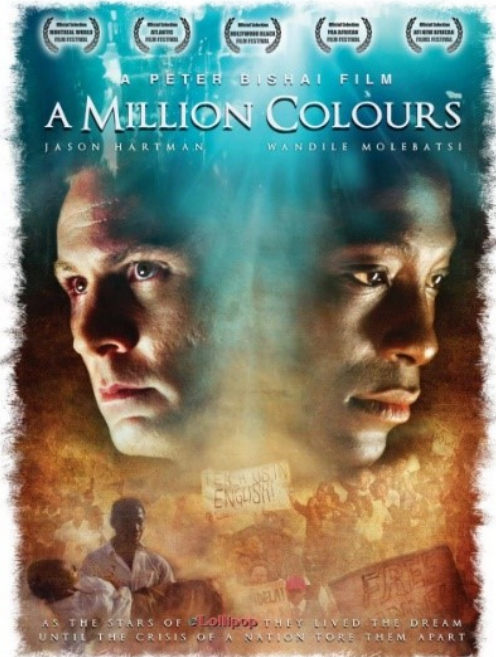

Parkview

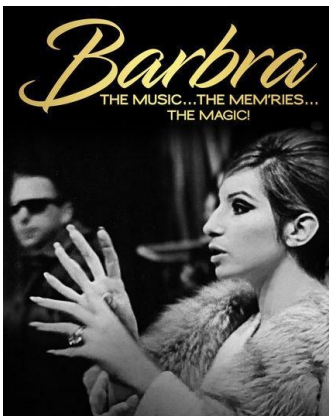
